Dear Phil,

I am writing to thank PHD interactive for generously donating £2,575 to Merlin, raised through collective donations from you clients over the past 13 months. Merlin is able to use funds such as these to respond to emergencies, such as the severe storm that struck Jalojai camp in Pakistan on 23rd June 2010, home to over 100,000 internally displaced people.

Our teams responded immediately, working day and night to re-establish health services that were decimated. Since the storm, we have prioritised setting up primary health centres and pharmacies in all six locations where our clinics once stood. We are also sending our team of health promoters, themselves displaced people, out into the community to screen other displaced people for injuries and inform them that these facilities are now re-opening.

Merlin's Pakistan Country Director Patrick Parsons says "In addition to rebuilding our clinics, the storm caused an estimated \$50,000 worth of losses to Merlin's programme in Pakistan through the destruction of drugs, equipment and patient records. It is a devastating loss, but we are determined to continue delivering health care for the people of Jalojai."

Once again a huge thank you for so generously supporting Merlin. Your support will enable us to continue to rapidly respond in these situations, meaning that thousands of people worldwide can continue to access medical care.
